



GENERAL INFORMATION

Tourists visiting Algeria or Tunisia have right to certain reductions in fares :

1. RAILWAYS.

- a) 50 % reduction for parties of 10 persons on French, Algerian and Tunisian railways, making the return journey, or for parties of a smaller number paying for ten.
- b) 62 1/2 % reduction on Algerian and Tunisian railways for honeymoon couples (whether of French or other nationality).
- c) 40 % reduction on fares from the entry-point in France to the port or embarkation for North Africa, and vice versa, in the case of foreign tourists making an inclusive tour in Algeria or Tunisia arranged by a travel agency.

2. SHIPPING COMPANIES.

Reductions are allowed under various headings—tourists making an inclusive tour, or travelling in parties, and honeymoon couples.

3. COMBINED TICKETS.


Combined return tickets for long stays (40 to 90 days) are issued by shipping companies, travel agencies, and by many French railway stations, direct to the main Algerian and Tunisian ports and railway stations, and include the following reductions :

TICKETS	sea voyage	land journey (in France)
40-day tickets, 1st class	25 %	10 %
2nd and 3rd class	20 %	10 %
90-day tickets, All classes	10 %	10 %

4. TOURIST TRAVEL CARD.

Tourists holding a " Tourist Travel Card ", issued for France, benefit in Algeria by the same reduction as regards train journeys (40 %) and purchase of petrol.

There is also a separate Tunisian tourist card (" Carte de Légitimation "), which entitles French or foreign travellers living outside French North Africa to a reduction of 50 % on all railways and passenger autocar services in Tunisia.



INTERCHANGEABILITY OF SHIPPING COMPANIES' TICKETS.

Return tickets are interchangeable between the French shipping companies steamers calling at Algerian, Tunisian or Moroccan ports. There is, of course, a modification in the fare when the passage out and back is made on ships of a different category.


CLOTHING TO WEAR. — In North Africa the nights are often cool, and day and night temperatures can vary perceptibly. One should therefore

dress as in Europe : light woolen clothes, but a warm coat; linen or duck dresses or suits to be avoided.

PASSEPORTS.

a) **for Algeria.** — With the exception of French, Belgian or Luxemburg nationals, all travellers must hold passports, and persons from certain countries (not Great Britain) must have visas.

b) **for Tunisia.** — With the exception of persons of French or Belgian nationality, all travellers must hold passports, and persons from certain countries (not Great Britain) must have visas.
