INFORMATION

Information concerning travel on the French Railways can be obtained in Great Britain from the principal Travel Agents, or French Railways Ltd. 179 Piccadilly, London, W.1, in France from any French Railway station and in Paris from the French Railway Enquiry Offices at 127 avenue des Champs-Élysées and 16 boulevard des Capucines, or by calling up LAborde 92.00.

TICKETS

Tickets, single or return, 1st, 2nd or 3rd class, between any two stations in France and between the principal stations in France and most other European countries or through tickets from London or the English Channel ports to the principal Continental destinations issued by the British Railways (Southern Region), can be obtained from the principal Travel Agents or French Railways Ltd. 179 Piccadilly, London W.1.

RESERVATION OF SEATS & SLEEPING BERTHS

Seats, cabins or sleeping berths may be reserved in advance on most cross-channel services and on long distance trains from Paris through most of the offices and agencies mentioned above. Passengers are recommended in their own interests to take advantage of this facility. Similar reservations can be made for the return journey from the principal stations in France.

REGISTRATION OF LUGGAGE

Heavy luggage can be registered between any two railway stations in France, and from London or the English Channel ports to most Continental destinations to which through tickets are issued, with a free allowance of 66 lbs. for adults and 44 lbs. for children between the 4 and 10 years of age. Any excess weight must be paid for.


PLACES OF INTEREST

AIX-EN-PROVENCE : Cathedral (XI th and XV th cent.) Church of St. Jean de Malte. Archiepiscopal Palace. Méjane Library (rare manuscripts). - **AJACCIO** : Cathedral. Napoleon and Fesch Museums. Imperial Chapel. Baptistery and House of Napoleon. - **ARLES** : Cathedral and Cloister of St. Trophime (XII th and XIV th c.). Roman Arena and Theatre. The Alyscamps. In the vicinity, the Abbey of Montmajour and Daudet's "Moulin". - **AVIGNON** : Ramparts. Palace of the Popes (XIV th c.). Pont d'Avignon (XII th c.) At Villeneuve-les-Avignon : Tower of Philippe-le-Bel (XIV th c.) and Fort St. André (XIV th c.). - **FREJUS** : Remains of Roman ramparts, arena, aqueduct, Roman baths, theatre, the Beacon of Augustus. Cathedral of St-Etienne (X th c.). Archeological museum. - **GRASSE** : Cathedral (XII th c.). Bishop's Palace. Mediaeval Tower. Fragonard Museum. - **HYERES** : Castle and ramparts. Churches of St-Louis (XII th c.) and St-Paul (XII th & XV th c.). The Tower of St-Blaise (XII th c.). Templars' Commandery. - **NIMES** : Roman Arena, Temples and Tower, the Roman aqueduct of the Pont du Gard. - **TARASCON** : Château du Roi René (XV th c.) 17 th cent. Town Hall. The Condamine Gate (1379) and the St-Jean Gate (1757). - **UZES** : Old City : Towers, Ducal Castle, Cathedral. The Fenestrelle Tower (XI th c.). - **VAISON-LA-ROMAINE** : Ruins of an old Roman city.


